Melbourne born pianist Hannah Shin, a student of Glen Riddle at Melbourne University, began studying piano at the age of eight and was awarded her LMusA diploma at the age of twelve. Hannahs debut solo recital was at the age of thirteen.

Hannah has since performed concertos by Tchaikovsky, Prokofiev, Liszt, Chopin and Beethoven with various Melbourne orchestras. Her debut in 2014 was performing Tchaikovsky's Piano Concerto No. 1 with the Zelman Memorial Symphony Orchestra and has appeared with the Thailand Philarmonic and Ningbo Symphony Orchestras as well as the Poland International Quartet.

Hannah was the youngest pianist invited to play in 3MBS' Beethoven Marathon and has performed and been broardcast on ABC FM, Kansas Public Radio and China Central TV. More importantly, she has performed in the USA, China, Denmark, Russia, Thailand, Korea, Malaysia and Indonesia.

Hanna's success in international competition in Beijing, Thailand and America are almost legendary. As a Chamber musician, she has excelled in her communication skills and natural talent.
